**TRADE UNION AMENDMENT ACT 2002**

[Date of Assent: 12 July 2002]

[Operative Date: 12 July 2002]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Trade Union Act 1965 to include a federation of unions within the definition of trade union:

Be it enacted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Assembly of Bermuda, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**Citation**

1 This Act may be cited as the Trade Union Amendment Act 2002.

**Amendment of section 1 of the Trade Union Act 1965**

2 Section 1(1) of the Trade Union Act 1965 is amended in the definition of "trade union" by inserting after the word "trade" where it appears immediately preceding the proviso the words "and includes a federation of trade unions".
